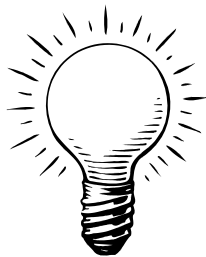

Penny a Mile Walking Program

Polish your walking shoes; dig out the pedometer and the St. John's water bottle.

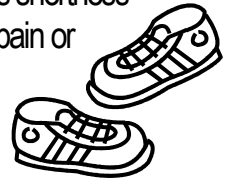
It's time to start walking!

Team members may (this is strictly voluntary) contribute 1 penny per mile walked and teams may choose which St. John's organization or group will receive the proceeds.

Before starting on a new walking program, be sure to check with your doctor.

If you develop any symptoms, such as shortness of breath, dizziness, faintness, chest pain or any other new symptoms, stop exercising and seek medical help immediately.



Studies have proven that a minimum of 30 minutes of moderate activity on most days of the week will reduce the risk of heart disease, diabetes, cancer and obesity by 55%. It is said that a trip of a thousand miles begins with the first step, so if you are a beginning walker, do not be discouraged!
